Campaign Priorities



What is God calling us to do?

Our current growth and increased emphasis on ministry to children and their families have exposed a number of needs and opportunities on our campus. We value an attractive facility reflecting the glory of God where possibilities and transformation take place. Our facility is aging and is in vital need of updating to enhance Saint Mark's ministry effectiveness. Our sanctuary is in need of repairs/renovations to continue to maximize its capability. Our children and youth facilities are at capacity on most Sundays and they are inadequate to meet the 21st Century learning needs of our children. The junior and senior high ministries lack the creative space necessary to attract and engage our students.

Therefore, we e have three specific goals. First, we want to eliminate the existing mortgage debt; Second, we will enhance our sanctuary with much needed repairs and renovations and; Finally we plan to expand our facilities for children and youth.

Here are the details: Priority One



• To Eliminate Existing Mortgage Debt (\$736,000) This will free up approximately \$17,000 per month to focus staff and resources to develop and implement ministries that cultivate small group development, ministry to children and their families, a high energy youth ministry, growth in worship attendance and enables us to return to giving 100% our United Methodist apportionment to support worldwide ministry and mission. Additionally, we will fulfill our commitment to the Annual Conference Bridges To The Future capital campaign.

Priority Two

• Enhance Campus & Renew Current Campus (\$789,000)

The second goal is to repair and renew an aging building to live out our value of an attractive facility that reflects the glory of God and facilitates the expansion of His Kingdom. This will include additional parking, new carpet, updated seating, lighting and staging in the sanctuary, and improved technological capabilities in existing classrooms.



Priority Three

 Expand Children & Youth Space (\$1,475,000)

Our goal is to create an experiential, participatory, image rich environment for children. This space will be specially designed to minister to the unique needs and learning styles of our children and youth. This will be a place where children and youth can find God's direction during this critical time of their lives. This would triple our capacity to provide meaningful ministry to children, youth and families.

Our response to these and the other challenges before us will determine if we continue to grow and expand our ministry or settle comfortably into our current state of being. As a people of faith and progress, it is clear that we will choose the path that leads to continued growth and expansion.

Saint Mark, Imagine the possibilities! We are asking every member of our family, every person who shares in our ministry, and everyone who has a heart to see the Gospel expand, to do three things: Pray confidently, Commit boldly, Give generously and sacrificially. The time has come to step out in faith.

These needs are necessitating a "re-tooling." In this new season we must launch a journey of stewardship that will deepen our personal faith, unify our corporate life and enhance our ministry effectiveness.

The best place to begin is by talking with God about what's on your heart and mind, specifically in relation to this giving commitment. Be honest and open about it.

Even in the nuts and bolts of sorting out financial questions, this is a spiritual journey. It's not about guilt or obligation. Remember, the idea isn't to figure out a mathematical formula, it's about giving Jesus access to your heart and letting him lead you in financial decisions.

Online Giving



The Bible has a lot to say about giving, and the promises attached to it. Giving is a responsibility and a privilege. With that in mind, I want to share with you four biblical principles on giving from 1 Corinthians 16:1-2.

FIRST, EVERY BELIEVER IN EVERY CHURCH SHOULD GIVE.

Giving is a universal practice. The apostle Paul told the Corinthian believers, "Follow the same procedure I gave to the churches in Galatia" (NLT). In other words, Paul was saying, "They did it in Galatia—you need to do it in Corinth. They did it in Macedonia, and we need to do it here. Every church should do this." It was not just something the Corinthians were asked to do; it is asked of every believer. No one is exempt from giving.

SECOND, WE LEARN THAT GIVING IS TO BE DONE CONSISTENTLY

AND REGULARLY. "On every Lord's Day," Paul said in verse two, "put aside some amount of money in relation to what you have earned" (NLT). The idea is to consistently take a percentage of your income and set it aside for the work of God. This is what the Scripture tells us we ought to do. And then, as you do this, you are able to invest it in his kingdom.

THIRD, GIVING IS A PERSONAL ACT.

Notice that Paul says, "each of you should put aside some amount of money " (verse 2, NLT). Paul's point is that every one of us should set aside an amount of money to give. Even children ought to be taught this. Giving to God's work is a personal act for every single believer.

FOURTH AND LASTLY, WE SHOULD PREPARE OURSELVES TO INVEST IN THE WORK OF GOD.

The apostle Paul told the believers "put aside some amount of money in relation to what you have earned and save it for this offering" (1 Corinthians 16:2, NLT). Paul is saying to prayerfully consider how much to give. Do it in advance. It should never be a last-minute or flippant practice. Paul also says, "in relation to what you have earned." In other words, not all of our gifts will be equal, but our sacrifice should be. Our giving should be in proportion to what we earn. Giving is an opportunity to be an obedient Christian. Take it seriously, but do it cheerfully.

Discover

SAINT MARK'S God-Given Purpose and YOUR God-Given Calling: How will we meet our goal?



DELIBERATE - Talk With GOD

First we ask that you go to God and ask that his will be done in your life. It's important that you are striving to follow the direction he has for you and that you find the doors he wants you to walk through.



DEFINE - What Sacrifice Looks Like for You

What changes can you make in your life that will better enable you to invest in what you believe in? How can you give in ways that will make a difference in you?



DETERMINE - A Starting Point

Imagine the Possibilities is based on "Not equal gifts, but equal sacrifice." In other words, not all of our gifts will be of the same amount, but every one of us can meaningfully invest in proportion to the resources God has given us to work with. Your 3-year commitment is to be a demonstration of the definition of sacrifice that God has revealed to you.

We thought it would be helpful to explain what commitment IS and IS NOT. A commitment IS a heartfelt decision to get behind what Saint Mark is doing - and it's something you make that's between you and God. A commitment IS NOT a contract or legal agreement. It's not between you and the Finance department.



DECIDE - Create a Personal Giving Plan

Prayerfully come up with a three-year plan of giving that goes above and beyond your regular tithe. Remember, we are not just constructing buildings; we are investing in bringing the gospel of Jesus Christ to this and future generations.

Want to be involved but not sure how?

If you're excited about getting involved, but you're not sure where to start, let us help you out! The truth is, there are several creative ways to contribute to our Imagine the Possibilities campaign. Here are a few:

DECREASE



Is there something in your daily life that you can take advantage of less frequently? By decreasing a weekly expense, regardless of what it may be, you can save significant amount of money to contribute to Imagine the Possibilities.

Things I can decrease:

Cut back on coffee drinks. Go out to dinner less. Adjust cable packages.

DELAY



Are there any plans that you might be making that involve a commitment? If so, prayerfully consider delaying these plans and use that extra income to contribute

Things I can delay:

Wait on that remodeling project.

Take that vacation next winter.

Wait to buy a new car.

DO MORE



Considering some creative ways you can do more is another way you can give to Imagine the Possibilities. Perhaps it's been a while since you've gotten another quote on an existing service. Maybe you can do some extra comparison or bargain shopping.

Shop around.

Pay off a bill, keep giving that amount, but give to Imagine the Possibilities.

DONATE
